Poem should be no longer than 40 lines and **kept to one page**

We require an entry form with each poem and 2 copies of the poem: one **with** your name and one **without**.

**Only 2 poems per participant may be submitted. No poems will be accepted after the deadline: No exceptions!** Lack of proper submission will result in disqualification
